Role Overview

Hands-on position responsible for finishing and building the millwork and cabinetry assemblies used in the manufacturing of our Lifestyle Vans. Take CNC-machined components and complete post processing, build preparation, final assembly, and quality control. Contribute as needed to fulfill the collective responsibilities of the CNC/Assembly team.

Essential Functions

- Finish component parts in preparation for assembly: includes routing, sanding, inspection.
- Use power and hand tools to process and assemble components into installation-ready assemblies.
- Build all assemblies consistently to the quality standards and fabrication specifications set by the shop manager.
- Check assembled components to ensure they meet the standard set by the shop manager.
- Follow the build cadence set by the shop manager, track progress accurately and in a timely manner, and coordinate daily to meet the goals of the CNC/Assembly team.
- Keep track of and notify the shop manager when parts and supplies are running low.
- Keep a clean, organized, and efficient work space.
- Strive for continuous improvement in your workspace and other areas of the shop.
- Abide by all shop safety standards.

Ideal Experience

- Prior manufacturing / fabrication experience with some labor trade experience (construction, carpentry, etc.) helpful.
- Proven experience operating hand tools and other typical woodworking tools.
- Proven ability to complete repetitive tasks with a high degree of meeting quality control standards.
